APPLICATION PROCESS FOR STUDENTS

Nomination process

Home university coordinators should nominate prospective Erasmus+ students in **our mobility system**. Nomination link with instructions is sent to each partner university coordinator by e-mail. Upon such nomination, students receive a unique link by e-mail to access our mobility system and complete their **e-application**.

Incoming international staff members shall submit their applications via **online application link**: <https://mobility.slu.cz/en/>
Incoming teaching staff must be **individually accepted by respective institute** (according to the inter-institutional agreement). The acceptance will be based on the candidate's working plan and its adequacy to the teaching programme of faculty's host didactic unit. Silesian University welcomes **staff with disabilities**. Applicants with special needs will be contacted before the final approval of the acceptance. Final decision depends on extra services/ facilities available.

ECTS Methodology

The study of individual programmes and courses is carried out on the basis of a credit system corresponding to ECTS, in which one credit corresponds to 1/60 of average annual student workload. Each course included in the study plans is assessed according to its difficulty by a certain number of credits that students earn.

Health Insurance

Students are requested to arrange comprehensive medical, accident, personal liability and possessions insurance

EU citizens (as well as citizens of Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Switzerland) - have a European Health Insurance Card, and are entitled to use it for urgent health care free of charge. It is highly recommended to have a supplementary travel health insurance.

Non-EU citizens, staying in Czechia longer than 3 months, must contract an insurance with an insurance company, which is licensed to operate the insurance in the territory of Czechia according to a special legal regulation.

Visa requirements for non EU-citizens

Students from **countries outside the EU** are required to obtain a visa or a residence permit. Czech visa is issued by the Czech embassy or consulate in a home country. Check the website of the Ministry of Interior of the Czech Republic for the latest information on visa/permit requirements.
