Each course included in the study plans is assessed according to its difficulty by a certain number of credits that students earn. ECTS Grading Scale A- excellent, B - very goof, C - good, D - satisfactory, E - sufficient, F - fail Z - PASS - some courses are not finalized by exam but ongoing activities are required (e,g, test, coursework, in-class presentation). The course is passed if the activities are sufficiently accomplished
