ECTS	<p>ECTS Methodology The study of individual programmes and courses is carried out on the basis of a credit system corresponding to ECTS, in which one credit corresponds to 1/60 of average annual student workload. Each course included in the study plans is assessed according to its difficulty by a certain number of credits that students earn.</p> <p>ECTS Grading Scale A- excellent, B - very good, C - good, D - satisfactory, E - sufficient, F - fail Z - PASS - some courses are not finalized by exam but ongoing activities are required (e.g. test, coursework, in-class presentation). The course is passed if the activities are sufficiently accomplished</p>

Health Insurance	<p>Students are requested to arrange comprehensive medical, accident, personal liability and possessions insurance</p> <p>EU citizens (as well as citizens of Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Switzerland) - have a European Health Insurance Card, and are entitled to use it for urgent health care free of charge.
