

Supplement to the "Conditions for the admission procedure to the follow-up Master's degree program in Economics and Management accredited in English in the full-time form of study (hereinafter "Conditions") of the Silesian University in Opava, School of Business Administration in Karviná for the academic year 2020/2021"

Approved by the Academic Senate of the SU SBA on 27 May 2020

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 49, Paragraph 5 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions, and on Amendments to Other Acts (Act on Higher Education Institutions), as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act on Higher Education Institutions"), in accordance with the Rules of the Admission Procedure at the Silesian University in Opava, as amended, and in accordance with the "Conditions" of 06 November 2019,

the Dean supplements the "Conditions" of 06 November 2019 with the conditions:

- For applicants who were admitted to study on the basis of the Conditions of the Admission Procedure to the follow-up Master's degree program in Economics and Management accredited in English in the full-time form of study at the Silesian University in Opava, School of Business Administration in Karviná for the academic year 2019/2020 and who, due to the negative effects of the coronavirus pandemic, could not be enrolled in the study in the given academic year, shall submit an application for study on the basis of "Conditions" dated 06.11.2019, the entrance exam will be waived.
- An applicant may be enrolled conditionally if, due to the negative effects of a coronavirus pandemic, he/she does not have an officially certified copy of a decision on the recognition of foreign higher education available on the day of enrollment. In this case, he/she is obliged to deliver this document no later than 45 days after the beginning of the academic year 2020/2021 (i.e. by 15 October 2020). If he/she fails to do so, after the expiration of this period the admission to study and enrollment in the study will cease to be valid and effective and such a student is considered a person who has not been enrolled in the study (see Act No. 188/2020 Coll.).
