PUSTEVNY & WALKWAY VALAŠKA

Pustevny, built by world-wide famous architect Dušan Jurkovič, is the most popular touristic resort in Beskydy mountains as well as a statue of Radegast which you will find on the way of our relaxing walk to the mountain Radhošť, the most iconic symbol of the whole Moravian-Silesian region. CHURCH & CHATEAU FRYŠTÁT

Karviná is a university, tourist, and spa city as well as a statutory town in the Moravian-Silesian region and it lies in the historical region of Cieszyn. The center of the town today is originally the princely town of Fryštát where, the Gothic Roman Catholic Church of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross which is the oldest relic of the region, is located as well. One of the most secret ways how to get to the neighboring chateau is under the ground.
