Article 1

Introductory provisions

This Decision announces the Rector's Scholarship Programme to support the study of Ukrainian students in the period from 1 April 2025 to 31 December 2025 at the Silesian University in Opava (hereinafter referred to as "the University") and sets out the conditions for the award of an extraordinary scholarship pursuant to Article 7(1)(c) of the University's Scholarship Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the Scholarship Regulations"), as amended.

Article 2

Definition of the range of students and conditions for awarding the scholarship

- 1) An exceptional scholarship will be awarded to students with Ukrainian citizenship who have been prevented from continuing or entering Ukrainian universities in connection with the armed

conflict in Ukraine. The exceptional scholarship will be awarded to current students and students admitted and enrolled in the academic year 2025/2026.

- 2) Students must also meet the following conditions:
 - a) for payment of the scholarship in the first instalment: as of 1 April 2025, they have obtained a credit score of 10 or more credits for completed courses, their studies are active (uninterrupted and not terminated) and they are reported in the SIMS register as of 31 March 2025 with the status "refugee";
 - b) for the payment of the second instalment of the scholarship: on 30 September 2025, their studies are active (uninterrupted and uncompleted), they have temporary protection and they are listed as a "refugee" on the SIMS register.
- 3) The scholarship will be awarded without the student's application, a positive decision will be issued immediately after verification of the conditions under paragraph 2.
- 4) The agenda related to the registration of scholarships is maintained by the authorized employee of the Rector's Office for Student and Social Affairs.

Article 3

Amount of scholarship

The scholarship will be

- a) in the first instalment according to the terms of Article 2(2)(a) in a lump sum of CZK 20,000;
- b) in the second instalment under the terms of Article 2(2)(b) in a single lump sum as a pro rata part of the total amount of CZK 460 000,-, rounded up to the nearest whole ten koruna.

Article 4

Payment of the scholarship

- 1) Any student who meets the conditions for the award of the scholarship will be paid the exceptional scholarship in the first instalment no later than the end of May 2025 and in the second instalment no later than the end of October 2025.
- 2) The scholarship is paid in with the Scholarship Regulations after the legal validity of the decision on their award, in cashless form to the student's bank account listed in the IS - if the student does not have valid bank details filled in the IS, the scholarship will not be paid.

Article 5

Common provisions

- 1) Reduction and withdrawal of the scholarship is regulated in Article 18 of the Scholarship Regulations.
- 2) Decisions are delivered via the IS SU.

Article 6

Final provisions

This Decision shall take effect on the date of issue and shall be effective on 1 April 2025.
